Plug in cheer this holiday season

That twinkling tree is the heart of your holiday decor. But without proper care, it can become a fire hazard.

Keep your holidays safe with a few simple steps.

- If you love a real tree, pick one with springy green needles that don't shed easily. Give the trunk a fresh cut before placing it in water, and top off the stand daily. A dry tree can ignite faster than you'd think. Keep it far from fireplaces, radiators or heat vents.
- For artificial trees, make sure the label says "fire-resistant." Before hanging a single ornament, check your lights for frayed cords or loose connections. Replace damaged strings. Don't try to fix them.
- Use LED lights if possible. They stay cool, use less energy, last longer and allow more strands per outlet. And when the night winds down, always unplug your lights before bed.
- Inspect all your electrical decorations before you use them to make sure there are no exposed wires or damaged sockets.
- Always turn off all indoor and outdoor electrical decorations before going to bed or leaving your home.

A safe setup takes minutes, but it protects everything and everyone you love.

Sign up for Operation Roundup

In this season of giving, consider signing up for Kenergy's Operation Roundup program and helping fellow members in need. In an effort to help members who struggle to pay their Kenergy bills due to a temporary emergency situation, our co-op started a nonprofit—Operation Roundup. To date, Kenergy members have donated \$134,947.

Enrolling is completely voluntary and takes just a few minutes. By signing up, you allow Kenergy to “round up” your payment to the next dollar. For example, if your bill is \$96.26, you would agree to pay \$97. The difference between the two amounts becomes your donation to Operation Roundup.

Using this easy system of giving, the average donor gives about \$6 each year.



Operation Roundup donations are tax deductible. Funds stay local, helping only fellow Kenergy members in need.
