When the power goes out, we work hard to resume service as quickly and safely as possible.

Here are some common reasons the power goes out:



STORMS:

Mother Nature can interfere with power delivery.



TREES AND VEGETATION:

This is why we work so hard to keep power lines clear.



ANIMALS:

Curious animals can cause damage, especially squirrels.



ACCIDENTS: Run-ins with a utility pole or other equipment can cause an outage.



PUBLIC DAMAGE: Unsafe digging, equipment or line damage, vandalism or theft can all interfere.



OVERLOAD: This happens when demand spikes, like on a hot summer day.

EQUIPMENT ISSUES: We maintain and inspect equipment regularly, but sometimes malfunctions occur.

2021 DIRECTOR ELECTION

IN KITCHEN Slow Cooker Salsa Chicken Taco Recipe

Start the new year off right with an easy dinner idea!

INGREDIENTS

- **2 pounds** boneless, skinless chicken breast
- 2 cups (1 jar) Chi Chi's Smoky Chipotle Salsa
- 2 tablespoons taco seasoning
- flour or corn tortillas, heated
- sliced avocado
- crumbled queso fresco
- chopped cilantro

DIRECTIONS

- Spray slow cooker with nonstick cooking spray. Add chicken, salsa, and taco seasoning to slow cooker and stir to combine. Cook chicken on HIGH for 4-6 hours, until chicken falls apart and shreds easily with a fork. Shred chicken with two forks.
- 2. Layer tortillas with salsa chicken and desired toppings like sour cream, lettuce, black beans, guacamole or pico!
