This step allows us to limit the direct exposure of our members and employees. Our service and field personnel will also be employing "social distancing." Kentucky weather can be unpredictable. When a storm hits, the damage it has done can be unclear. Storms often damage power lines, exposing people to deadly dangers. Keep your family and neighbors safe with these downed-line safety tips during a storm recovery.

Stay SAFE around downed power lines:

- If you see a downed power line, move away from it and anything touching it. Keep a distance of 40 feet, as the ground around downed power lines may be energized.
- Assume ALL downed power lines are live.
- If you see someone in direct or indirect contact with a downed line, DO NOT touch him or her. You could become energized as well.
 Call 911 for assistance.
- NEVER attempt to move a downed power line or anything else in contact with it using an object such as a broom or stick. Non-conductive materials like wood or cloth can conduct electricity if slightly wet.
- Don't step in water near downed lines.
- Never drive over a downed power line.
- If your vehicle comes in contact with a downed power line while you're in the vehicle,

- stay inside the car. Call 911 or honk your horn to get help, but tell those rendering aid to stay away from the vehicle.
- If you must exit the vehicle for life-threatening reasons—jump out and away from it, making sure to land with your feet together and touching. Then, shuffle away with your feet touching until you are at least 40 feet from the vehicle. NEVER attempt to get back into a vehicle that is in contact with a power line.



Banana Bread Recipe

We don't know what it is about self isolation, but it seems to make everyone want to bake! Try this classic banana bread recipe out while you're staying safe at home. Thank you to Member Service Representative Susie Humphrey for sharing her favorite recipe.



INGREDIENTS

All ingredients should be at room temperature.

3 large extra ripe bananas, mashed

1 teaspoon lemon juice

2 cups all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon baking powder

1/, teaspoon salt

1¹/₂ teaspoon cinnamon

1/, cup white sugar

1/2-3/4 cup brown sugar

1 stick butter, softened

2 eggs beaten

1¹/₂ teaspoons vanilla extract

1/2 cup buttermilk

DIRECTIONS

- Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- 2. Grease and flour a loaf pan.
- 3. In a medium size bowl, mash bananas until creamy and stir in lemon juice. Set aside.
- 4. In a medium size bowl, whisk together flour, baking soda, baking powder, cinnamon and salt. Set aside.
- In a large bowl, cream together the butter and sugars.
- 6. Beat in the eggs until combined.
- 7. Fold in the bananas.
- 8. Add in the vanilla extract and buttermilk.
- 9. Beat until combined.
- 10. Add the dry mixture into the wet mixture. Stir gently until the flour is incorporated. Do not over
- 11. Pour the batter into the prepared loaf pan.
- 12. Bake on center rack for 1 hour and 10 minutes. Cooking times may vary. Check on bread at the



- one hour mark. Toothpick inserted into the center should come out clean and bread should be golden on the outside.
- 13. Brush the top of the bread with butter if desired when it comes out of the oven.
- 14. Let cool for five minutes and then remove the bread from the pan and place on a cooling rack to finish cooling.
- 15. Slice and enjoy!
